Other Locational Data: From I-15 North, take exit 27 for Via Rancho Parkway toward Felicita Park/San Diego Wild Animal Park. Turn right onto E Via Rancho Parkway, and continue onto Bear Valley Parkway. Turn right onto San Pasqual Road and continue onto CA-78 E/San Pasqual Valley Road. Continue two miles; the project area is on the north side of CA-78. There is an access gate and road to enter the existing orchard, permission is required to enter the property.

Project Description, Methods, and Results: The proposed project is an administrative permit modification proposing a small winery tasting facility. The project site is located within an existing orchard and vineyard.

The field survey was conducted using standard archaeological procedures and techniques. To the extent feasible, continuous parallel transects of approximately 10 meters were walked in a generally north/south direction for the existing orchard, and east/west for the vineyard portions.

The project area is a working orchard and vineyard and visibility was approximately 70%. Vegetation debris were present over a majority of the project area (Attachment A). Soils throughout the parcel were a mixture of medium brown sandy loams. The soils have been disturbed through the long history of agriculture within the project site, and no native soils with potential to contain cultural material were observed. The project site contained several rodent back dirt piles through the orchard, which were periodically inspected for evidence of cultural resources. No cultural material was observed during the pedestrian survey (Attachment A).

Prior Research: Staff conducted a records search of the surrounding area using the California Historic Resources Inventory System (CHRIS). A total of 30 cultural studies have been conducted within a one mile radius (Table 1). Fourteen prehistoric archaeological sites, one multi-component archaeological site, and three historic buildings have been identified within a one-mile radius. The results of the records search are detailed in Tables 1-3.

Recommendations: Due to the active and historical use of the parcel as an orchard, the project area is highly disturbed. While agricultural use does not preclude the presence of cultural resources, the agricultural activities and movement of soils in the current project site indicates soil conditions that are not conducive to inadvertent discoveries of cultural material. No cultural materials or landscape features (i.e. water source, bedrock outcrops) indicative of cultural resources were observed within the proposed project area. Due to the absence of cultural resources and existing disturbances, no further cultural resources studies are recommended for the proposed project at this time.




