

Purpose of the Scoping Meeting


 Provide information early in the CEQA process

 Solicit your input on the scope of the environmental analysis, including environmental issues, alternatives, and mitigation measures we should study in the Supplemental EIR (SEIR)



Project Description

- Scoping Letter issued (2024)



What Does CEQA Require for a Notice of Preparation?

- CEQA Guidelines Section 15082 (a):
- (1) The NOP shall provide responsible and trustee agencies, OPR, Clerk with sufficient information describing the project and the potential environmental effects...to make a meaningful response. It shall include:
 - (A) Description of the project,
 - (B) Location of the project (either by street address and cross street...by attaching a map, preferably a copy of a USGS topographical map...), and
 - (C) Probable environmental effects of the project.
- (4) The lead agency may begin work on the draft EIR immediately without awaiting responses to the NOP. The draft EIR may need to be revised to conform to responses to the NOP.

Prepare Supplemental EIR

- What is the difference between a Subsequent EIR and Supplemental EIR?
- CEQA Guidelines Section 15162 Questions (paraphrased):
 - Substantial changes are proposed that require major revisions of the previous EIR due to new significant environmental effects or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant effects;
 - Substantial changes occur with respect to the circumstances under which
 the project is undertaken that require major revision of the previous EIR
 due to new significant environmental effects or a substantial increase in
 the severity of previously identified significant effects; or
 - New information of substantial importance, which was not known and could not have been known with the exercise of reasonable diligence at the time the previous EIR was certified.
