The County of San Diego (County) acknowledges the commenter's opposition to the Proposed Project. Adverse effects related to the environmental issues cited in this comment were considered and addressed in the Draft Program Environmental Impact Report (DPEIR). The environmental evaluation determined that the Proposed Project would have a less than significant impact on biological resources, cultural resources, groundwater wells, and hazards such as risk of wildfire and emergency response capabilities (see DPEIR Sections 2.3, 2.4, 3.14, 3.1.5, 3.1.7; common response WR1). Property values are not an environmental issue and as such, are not evaluated in the Environmental Impact Report (EIR). The information in this comment will be provided in the Final Program EIR (FPEIR) for review and consideration by the decision makers.
