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Potential adverse hydrological impacts of the Proposed Project were considered and addressed in the Draft Program Environmental Impact Report (DPEIR); see Sections 3.1.5 and 3.1.9. Please also refer to common response WR1 and WR2. Based on the environmental evaluation, it has been determined that the Proposed Project would have a less than significant impact on groundwater supply. Related to the commenter's concern regarding the potential loss of flora and fauna, it has been determined that the Proposed Project would have a less than significant impact on biological resources, including potential impacts to groundwater supporting sensitive habitat.

The County of San Diego (County) acknowledges the commenter's opposition to the Proposed Project. The information in this comment will be provided in the Final Program Environmental Impact Report for review and consideration by the decision makers.

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
