Owners of the real properties located at 2754 and 2750 Ribbonwood Road, Boulevard, CA.] We are extremely concerned about the large quantities of water being used and the reduction of the local aquifers. These aquifers presently support the fragile oak trees that 145-3 populate our properties and the adjacent properties around us. We would request that our water levels be monitored and any reduction of our water table be avoided. We believe that we will be severely impacted by the aesthetics and visual impacts of the projects, including possible reflections from the Concentrated Photovoltaic (CPV) trackers when we drive up Ribbonwood Road and/or when they track the sun as it sets to the west over 145-4 our properties. The Rugged Solar Project alone, involves over one square mile of CPV trackers near our properties to the north of the freeway. We object to each of the related projects (Tierra del Sol Solar Farm, Rugged Solar Farm, LanEast Solar Farm, LanWest Solar Farm and their supporting infrastructure projects) and the similar adverse effects that they will have over the rest of the Boulevard area. One of the most adverse effects is the direct negative impact on all of our "property 145-5 We support and endorse the well-documented opposition and objections to the Soltec Solar Development Projects as stated by and/or filed by the Boulevard Planning Group, Backcounty Against Dumps, and/or The Protect Our Communities Foundation.

Please refer to the response to comment O10-23, which discusses the Groundwater Mitigation and Monitoring Program (GMMP) that will be implemented for the Proposed Project, per Mitigation Measure M-BI-PP-15. For the Tierra del Sol Solar Farm, all wells to be monitored are listed in the GMMP, which are available for review on the County's administrative record for the Proposed Project. The administrative record for the Proposed Project can be found online http://www.sdcounty.ca.gov/pds/ceqa /SOITEC SOLAR DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRA TIVE_RECORDS.html. For the Rugged Solar Farm, all wells within one half mile of the Rugged site are eligible to be included in the monitoring program.

- The County agrees that the Proposed Project may result in potential adverse impacts related to aesthetics; these potential impacts are considered and addressed in Chapter 2.1, Aesthetics, of the DPEIR and response to comment I17-5.
- The County acknowledges the commenters' opposition to the Proposed Project. This comment raises concerns regarding property values. This topic was not evaluated in the DPEIR since it is not related to environmental impacts. See CEQA Guidelines section 15131. However, this type of information can be presented to decision makers for their consideration during the hearing process for the project. The information in this
