The County of San Diego (County) acknowledges the commenter's opposition to the Proposed Project. Adverse effects related to the environmental issues cited in this comment are considered and addressed in the Draft Program Environmental Impact Report (DPEIR). The County found that the Proposed Project would have a less than significant impact on biological resources, cultural resources, groundwater wells, and hazards such as risk of wildfire and emergency response capabilities (see DPEIR Chapters 2.3, 2.4, 3.1.4, 3.1.5, 3.1.7; common response WR1 and WR2). The issue of property values is not an environmental impact, and as such was not evaluated in the DPEIR. The information in this letter will be provided in the Final Program Environmental Impact Report (FPEIR) for review and consideration by the decision makers.
