

## **Response to Comment Letter I78**

The County of San Diego (County) acknowledges the commenter's opposition to the Proposed Project. The information in this comment will be provided in the Final Program Environmental Impact Report (FPEIR) for review and consideration by the decision makers.

The Proposed Project's potential environmental impacts related to groundwater use are discussed in Sections 3.1.5.3, Groundwater Resources, and 3.1.9.3, Water. See also common response WR1 and WR2. Private wells in the vicinity of the Proposed Project will not be affected significantly since the Proposed Project's groundwater usage will be capped within County thresholds under the Major Use Permit to prevent potential drawdown of adjacent wells. As such, it is not anticipated that there will be significant impacts to wells of neighboring residents as a result of the Proposed Project.

Issues raised in this comment related to potential adverse effects to oaks (*Quercus* sp.) and fire danger were considered and addressed in the Draft Program Environmental Impact Report (DPEIR; see Sections 2.3, Biological Resources, and 3.1.4.3, Wildfire Hazards). See response to comment C3-4 related to fire hazards.

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Final PEIR

The Rough Acres Ranch campground is considered a cumulative project in the DPEIR (see Table 1-12) and its impacts, combined with the potential impacts of the Proposed Project, were considered and addressed throughout the DPEIR consistent with CEQA Guidelines, 14 CCR § 15130.

This comment concludes the letter and does not raise an environmental issue. The County acknowledges the commenter's concern for water resources. The information in this letter will be provided in the FPEIR for review and consideration by the decision makers.
