- 19-3 The County has found that the Proposed Project would have a less than significant effect related to wildlife, birds of prey, and endangered species. These issues are discussed in Section 2.3.3 of the DPEIR.

The County has found that the Proposed Project would have a less than significant effect related to risk of fire and firefighting services. These issues are discussed in Sections 3.1.4.3.3, Wildfire Hazards, and 3.1.7.3.3, Fire and Emergency Medical Response Capabilities, of the DPEIR.
