Description: The field survey was conducted using standard archaeological procedures and techniques. For the most part, continuous parallel transects (10 meters) were walked in a north/south direction. Survey conditions in these areas were fair to poor, with most areas partially by ground cover in the form of grasses. In areas possessing dense vegetation, the survey methodology was adjusted to accommodate surface examination of trails and clearings and to facilitate the inspection of bedrock outcrops and stream beds. No artifacts or features were identified during this survey. This project proposes to divide the parcel into three subdivisions and the installation of an advance septic system for the three parcels.

Prior Research: Staff conducted a records search of the surrounding area using the California Historic Resources Inventory System (CHRIS). Twenty-five studies (Table 1) have been conducted within a one mile radius. Additionally, 17 sites (table 2) and 5 historic properties (Table 3) were identified within a one mile radius. See tables 2 and 3 for more details.
