The equestrian facility is located on 203.15 acres and is existing. The facility would remain while new components would be added which would be ancillary to the existing facility. Overall, the project would include a total of 15.91 acres of public and private parks as well as provide for the permanent preservation of 832.7 acres within a biological open space easement.
