Discussion began on the form-based code and allowed signage heights. Dyer said he would support Option 3 because it looked the most appropriate with regard to scope and scale. Other members expressed concern of backlash with the community if larger letters than 24" were approved.

Motion to approve Option 2 (at 24" tall) by Chris Anderson and seconded by Bruce Nolan. Motion passed 6-0-0-2.
