# <u>ITEM 3 - SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATION CENTER MAJOR SYSTEMS</u> RENOVATION

Property Owner: County of San Diego

Location: 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, CA

Supervisor District - All

#### **Description:**

The proposed project is to renovate the entire County Administration Center for life safety reasons as well as upgrade and rehabilitate the mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems and architectural items of the structure. The scope of work of the project would include:

- Replacement of air handling units
- Installation of new interior LED lighting
- Standardization of ceilings
- Installation of a fire sprinkler system throughout
- Restructuring of the security system
- Replacement of elevator equipment
- Upgrading new electrical panels
- Installation of new emergency generators
- Exterior painting
- Preservation of decorative dome tiles
- Upgrading of fire alarm system
- Window rehabilitation and/or replacement\*
- Rehabilitation and limited restoration of doors
- · Correction of identified accessibility barriers
