ITEM 3 – HERITAGE HERD BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Applicant: Kathleen Hayden; Coyote Canyon Caballos d'Anza Inc.

Location: N/A

Description: The applicant is requesting listing of the Heritage Herd (horses related to the Spanish horse) to the Local Register. The Colonial Spanish Heritage Herds played a major part in establishing Indian ranching and the cultural evolution of ranching in San Diego County. In 2003, four wild stallions were salvaged from the wild horse herd residing in Coyote Canyon, Anza Borrego Desert. These were the ancestral remnants of horses that

carried a Spanish military expedition into California in 1769 under the leadership of Gaspar de Portola. Today, the Coyote Canyon stallions are listed by the Equis Survival trust as extremely rare and extinct in the wild. Brood mares from Utah's Sulphur Springs herd were acquired to ensure the genetic future of the Coyote Canyon stallions.

Today's Action: Consider the data provided and whether the Historic Site Board should take action.

Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends that this item be denied as animals are not resources that can be listed under the Local Register of Historical Resources. A formal application nor analysis have been provided that identifies resources or criteria identified in the Local Register which would allow the Historic Site Board to consider the contribution of the Heritage Herd to that resource.
