

QUINO CHECKERSPOT BUTTERFLY




- Quino checkerspot butterfly (Quino)
- Habitat:
 - Scrub
 - Chaparral
 - Grassland
- Host and nectar plants include:
 - Dwarf plantain
 - California buckwheat
 - Purple owl's clover



NEED FOR THE QUINO ADDITION



- 1997: MSCP – South County Subarea Plan approved
- 1997: Quino listed as federally endangered
