3. Covered Species and Vegetation Communities

Multiple Species Conservation Program – North County Plan Materials for: Steering Committee Meeting #3

The Preserve design approach for the North County Plan is based on the concept of a Pre-Approved Mitigation Area or PAMA, within which the Preserve will be assembled. Various models and analyses were utilized to create the PAMA to ensure it included high biological value areas and corridors for the movement of species.

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


Figure 1: Vegetation Communities within Plan Area




Figure 2: Scrub Vegetation Community within Plan Area

Furthermore, the County's analysis has ensured that the species included within the Plan provide umbrella coverage for important vegetation communities within the Plan Area. **Table 1** shows the 29 species that are currently proposed as covered species in the North County Plan, and also shows the major vegetation communities within which each species is expected to be located. As shown in **Table 1**, together, the 29 species can be found within the seven major vegetation communities that are located within the Plan Area as shown in **Figure 1**. Additional maps that show the range of each vegetation community with respect to the Plan Area are provided in **Figures 2** to **8**.




Figure 3: Chaparral Vegetation Community within Plan Area




Figure 4: Grassland, Meadow and Seep Vegetation Communities within Plan Area




Figure 5: Vernal Pool Vegetation Community within Plan Area

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


Figure 6: Vernal Pool Vegetation in Ramona within Plan Area




Figure 7: Riparian and Bottomland Vegetation Communities within Plan Area




Figure 8: Upland Woodland and Forest Vegetation Communities within Plan Area
