Please note the following processing times and costs for discretionary permits are estimates only and may vary depending on project-specific factors and the required environmental review. These cost estimates are based on our staffing levels as of October 2025 and are for the time County staff spends on application. Applicants are responsible for covering all related costs, regardless of the initial estimate provided.

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Key Points to Note:

- Variation in Time and Costs: The time and cost associated with processing a discretionary permit requiring
 a deposit can differ greatly. Factors influencing this include the type of entitlement, project complexity, plan
 changes, applicants' responsiveness, and more.
- Potential for Cost Deviation: Actual costs might vary from the online estimates due to factors such as
 project location, environmental considerations, planning constraints, proposed changes, multiple meetings,
 appeals, or code/ordinance compliance.
- Applicants' Financial Responsibility: Applicants are required to cover all costs associated with application processing, regardless of the initial estimate provided or historical costs.

Additional Considerations:

- Significant Impacts: If a project is found to have a potentially significant impact, the initial cost estimate may be inaccurate, and additional deposits will be required.
- Concurrent Submittals: For projects requiring multiple permits, only one deposit (the highest amount) is required per department.

Basis of Estimates:

- Processing time and costs are based on historical data from completed projects and include all deposits based on PDS costs and applicable Department of Public Works (DPW), Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR), and Department of Environmental Health and Quality (DEHQ) costs.
- Estimates exclude applicant's consultant/engineering costs or costs for post-discretionary review (e.g., final map, condition satisfaction, etc.).

Project-Specific Factors:

- Cost estimates are contingent upon the project description, remaining consistent throughout the process and the applicant submitting requested information according to the schedule and timelines.
- Costs assume adherence to the project schedule assumptions and are paid in installments throughout the process.

Complex Projects:

- For projects requiring multiple permits, the cost estimate can be reviewed for additional permits required.
- Estimates are based on the relative cost of projects of similar complexity and exclude applicant's consultant/engineering costs and county costs for post-discretionary reviews (e.g., final map).
- Additional deposits for Trails Review, DEHQ review, or DGS review, etc., may be required.

All costs incurred by the County in processing the application, including overhead, whether within or over the project-specific estimate provided with the initial scoping letter, must be paid by the financially responsible party.

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
