# Youth Development Academy (YDA) - Secure Youth Treatment Facility (SYTF)

#### **529.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE**

The purpose of this policy is to establish the guidelines for the Youth Development Academy (YDA) - Secure Youth Treatment Facility (SYTF) that members must follow as set forth by SB 92 (2021) and the Welfare and Institutions Code § 875 with the closure of the Division of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) (SB 823 (2021); AB 200 (2022)).

#### **529.2 DEFINITIONS**

**Care Coordinator:** A designated Probation staff member who coordinates a multi-disciplinary collaborative approach to service delivery, facilitates conversations between multi-disciplinary team members, serves as a liaison for collaborative partners and ensures client service referrals are appropriately coordinated.

**Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT):** A group of persons with varied, but complementary experience, qualifications, and skills who collaborate to make recommendations and decisions for youth in the care of the Probation Department.

**Youth Development Academy (YDA):** San Diego County Probation Department's Secure Youth Treatment Track Facility.

#### **529.3 POLICY**

It is the policy of the Department to provide in-custody youth at YDA-SYTF with a reentry program that is multi-disciplinary, collaborative, and by state laws and Welfare Institution Codes. The intent is to achieve specific therapeutic and rehabilitative goals within the shortest commitment term necessary to promote a safe and successful reintegration into the community.
