Course Title: Adult Court Report Writing

- 3. Contact and accurately represent a Victim's statement
- 4. Complete an accurately formatted and researched criminal history
- 5. Identify and complete the Sentencing Data section to include Prison Term Breakdowns
- 6. Determine Probation Eligibility
- 7. Determine PC1170(h)(5) Eligibility
- 8. Make recommendations regarding PC1170(h)(5) sentencing as necessary
- 9. Input appropriate COMPAS information
- 10. Evaluate Circumstances to Grant/Deny Probation
- 11. Write an effective and analytical discussion with recommendation
- 12. Properly prepare and submit the PSI and associated documents for processing
