Course Title: Northpointe Suite Software and COMPAS SB135 Re-Entry Assessment Training

Instructional Time: 4- hours

Course Description:

This 4-hour curriculum will train participants in the administration of the COMPAS Re-Entry Risk Assessment, as configured by the agency for adult male and female offenders. There is an emphasis placed on Evidence-Based Practices and the RNR principles, the logic and validation of the COMPAS actuarial assessment, understanding the criminological theories that underlie the assessment, results interpretation, and case planning.

Performance Objectives

- 1. Perform active learning through in-session participation and competency review on the tools and resources to navigate the COMPAS software system.
- 2. Explain the relationship between evidence-based practice (EBP) in the criminal justice field, including NIC's 8 Principles of EBP and Andrews and Bonta's Risk, Need, Responsivity framework, and the criminological theories infused in the COMPAS assessment professional field practice.
- 3. Construct learning anchors between the relationship between EBP, criminological theories, and the COMPAS assessment that inform practical application.
- 4. Use responsivity principles throughout the assessment, case planning and supervision phases.
- 5. Identify the current business practices that exist to guide user's implementation of tools and resources in the software.
