

Course Title: **Human Trafficking**

Instructional Time: 4-hours

Course Description: Students will obtain a working knowledge of the laws, statutes, and mandates surrounding human trafficking. Students will recognize risks/warning signs of suspects/victims involved in human trafficking. Students will receive information on engaging with victims as well as resources to assist victims.

OBJECTIVES:

1. Define Human Trafficking and Identify penal code/federal statutes/legal mandates related to human trafficking.
2. Analyze human trafficking trends in San Diego County and nationally.
3. Explain human trafficking victimology and how to engage with victims of human trafficking.
4. Identify indicators, risk factors, and warning signs of human trafficking.
5. Explain common terminology and lifestyle of the human trafficking subculture.
6. Identify resources available to victims of human trafficking.
