

Course Title: **Static-99R**

Instructional Time: 12 hours

Course Description:

This course instructs participants in the development and coding of the STATIC-99R, an assessment tool that measures a sex offender's risk to sexually reoffend. The STATIC-99R was selected as the State Authorized Risk Assessment Tool for Sex Offenders (SARATSO). Since July 1, 2008, this assessment is mandated by law in California pursuant to PC290.04 to assess the risk of sexual recidivism in sex offenders who are involved with Probation, Parole, or CDCR. The training provides participants with skills to use the assessment tool 1) to score offenders appropriately to determine their risk to re-offend sexually, 2) interpret the risk and 3) forward the assessment to the appropriate State authorities.

Recommended for:

The class is designed for Adult Investigators, CTC staff, ICSU staff, Sex Offender Supervision Unit staff.

Performance Objectives:

1. Define basic terms and concepts regarding the process of assessing risk in sex offenders using the STATIC-99R tool.
2. Identify STATIC-99R risk factors and code each of the 10 items correctly.
3. Distinguish who needs to be scored using the STATIC-99R and who cannot be scored.
4. Read and interpret the STATIC-99R coding rules.
5. Score and code sex offenders with unusual risk factors.
6. Accurately complete STATIC-99R assessments and submit scores and FOS to the DOJ.1.
