Topic: **Mandatory Use of a Filtering Facepiece for Aerosol Transmissible Diseases**

Instructional Time: 2-hours

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

In order to comply with CCR's Title 8, Section 5199 regarding care of minors ill with an Aerosol Transmissible Disease (A.T.D.) in a correctional setting, officers will learn the state regulations and medical definitions of A.T.D.s. Officers will learn when and how to use the N95 respirator under mandatory use conditions. Officers will undergo the respirator fit testing process. Officers will learn policy and procedure on escort and care of minors isolation for an A.T.D. infection in Probation Facility.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1) Provide information on respirators and fit issues
- 2) Identify when officers should wear N95 respirators
- 3) Demonstrate use and proper fit of N95 respirator
- 4) Identify the 3 stages of surge care isolation inside the facility during a potential ATD epidemic
- 5) Define and Identify Probation Referring Facilities and Probation Treatment Facilities
- 6) Pass a written quiz on subject matter
