Institutional Services Operations Training Course Topic: ISOPS - Full Course Defensive Tactics

Instructional Time: 32-hours

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This is the entry level defensive tactics training designed for officers who work with youth in an institutional setting. This course will provide the student with a basic working knowledge of arrest methods and defensive tactics. Students will obtain the skills and knowledge necessary to defend themselves or others, take subjects into custody, overcome resistance, and prevent escape. This training also includes use of force, search and mechanical restraints, and scenarios.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1) Site departmental use of force policies and procedures
- 2) Demonstrate, to the satisfaction of the instructor, the ability to perform the basic principles of defensive tactics.
