

Grant Programs for Food Safety Certification Assistance

CDFA Produce Safety Program (PSP)

Supports grower compliance with the Produce Safety Rule through education, inspections, and training opportunities.



On-Farm Food Safety Project (OFFS)

Provides free tools and templates to help farms build food safety plans that meet GAP and FSMA requirements.



UC ANR Small Farm Food Safety – PSA Training Schedule

Offers multilingual PSA grower trainings and support for small farms.



USDA FSCSC Program

Reimburses growers for costs of obtaining or renewing GAP and other food safety certifications.



Grant Programs for Food Safety Certification Assistance

USDA AMS Harmonized GAP

National Good Agricultural Practices audit program verifying food safety practices for market access.



CDFA Resilient Food Systems Infrastructure (RFSI)

Funds postharvest, aggregation, processing, and distribution infrastructure.



NRCS EQIP (California)

Supports farmers and ranchers with assistance to implement conservation practices.



CDFA Farm to Community Food Hubs Grant

Supports development and enhancement of local food hubs and distribution networks.



Grant Programs for Food Safety Certification Assistance

Healthy Soils Program (HSP)

Funds soil-building practices that sequester carbon and improve soil health.



CDFA Farmer's Equity Grant Programs

Supports socially disadvantaged farmers with infrastructure and business resources.



CDFA Urban Agriculture Program

Funds agricultural projects in urban communities to improve food access.
