Award of the Contract, if awarded, will be to the lowest responsible bidder for the Total Bid, and subject to the Owner's right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informality or irregularity in the bids or bidding. Bids in which the prices are obviously unbalanced may be rejected. The County may deem non-responsive any bids that contain any mathematical errors.

Award of the Contract, if awarded, will be made within seventy-five (75) calendar days from the date specified for the opening of bids.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, additive alternatives if any not included in the initial award, may be added to and included into the contract following initial award by the delivery of a Notice to Proceed to Contractor.

Information requested on the Designation of Subcontractors and Bidder DVB Information forms are required for the total bid amount (i.e., base bid and all additive alternates, if any).

PROHIBITED CONTRACTS
