
If ave worked in the past for California Legislature as a Chief Committee Consultant to two different policy committees at various times in the late 1980's ard mid 1990's. More recently I worked for the County of Imperial as the Director of Intergovernmental Relations. In this capacity I was exposed to the redistricting process as it pertained to that county and assisted the County Executive Officer prepare background information to assist the Board of Supervisors in their redistricting deliberations. As Intergovernmental Relations Director for a public agency, I was responsible for monitoring pending legislation and regulations at the state and federal level that would affect the interests of that rural county, this work necesitated that I comprehend these legislative measures and interpret how they would affect the county whether in a positive or negative manner and suggest any action that the Board may wish to take.

In my role with Imperial County I also worked closely with officials from the 7 cities in Imperial County as well as with my counterparts in San Diego, Riverside and Yuma Counties as well as with the Ayuntamiento (county) of Mexicali, which are all neighboring jurisdictions to Imperial.

I retired over 10 years from Imperial County, at which time my wife and I repeated to San Diego County. I am very interested in continuing to pursue my interest in public service with a relatively short term assignment such as the redistricting commission would entail.




2. What experience do you possess that demonstrates an ability to be impartial?

I worked for the county board of superivisors in a county where the board, all hough officially non-partisa, was comprised of members of various political parties and backgrounds. In order to be effective it was necessary for me to provide advice based upon the factual effect a particular measure would have upon the interests of the county regardless of the politics involved. During my experience serving with the California Legislature as a chief committee consultant I was also tasked with preparing factual and non-partison analyses of legislative measures pending before the committee. I was also tasked with advising the committee chair of the legislative rules in order to ensure that deliberations before the committee were conducted in accordance with the rules of the legislature regardless of partisan positions.

3. What experience do you possess that demonstrates an appreciation for the diverse demographics and geography of the County of San Diego?

durrently live in north coastal San Diego County, but have explored virtually every town in the county during my travels while living here and during my time living in the Imperial County desert which borders San Diego to the east. I have also been required to assist residents of many different ethnic backgrounds while working for the county. Besides the dominant Mexican-American and Mexican populations in Imperial County; there are significant communities of Swiss, Sikh, Chinese, African American, Southeast As and Koreans, as well as one Indian tribal reservation among the relatively small population of the area. Each of these communities have or anizations and celebrations which I had the pleasure of being able to attend with members of the county board or on their behalf. These events along with snaller meetings over specific community needs enabled me to appreciate the special concerns and opportunities to assist these many diverse cultures that combine to create our overall community. During my tenure in Imperial County I gradually became somewhat conversational in Spanish, although this is still a work in progress.
