- IRC discussion and votes on motions (see slide 8 for details)
- Timeline for distribution of agenda materials (see slide 5 for schedule)
 - At Least 7 days prior to a Draft Map Public Hearing

Procedures for Map Drawing Meetings

- FLO Presentation on IRC draft maps
 - Map and Table with descriptive information/data for each Draft Map under consideration
- Public Comment or Hearing
 - Each person has up to 2 minutes to provide testimony
- Commissioner statements
 - Each commissioner has up to 2 minutes for opening comments. Comments prepared prior to meeting based on agenda materials and commissioner research. Can be updated based on public testimony. Must include:
 - Preferred map, list of at least 1 not more than 3. Staff records and displays table with this information during meeting
 - Why preferred (referencing statutory criteria)
 - Why other maps not preferred (referencing statutory criteria)
 - Other comments

Procedures for Map Drawing Meetings

- Motions to provide FLO with direction
 - Motion(s) to move a specific map (draft or public) forward for further consideration
 - Motion(s) to combine parts of a draft map with another draft map under consideration
 - Motion(s) to combine parts of a draft map with a map submitted by public
 - Motion(s) to change a draft map in a specific way

Procedures for Map Drawing Meetings

- IRC discussion and voting on motions to provide FLO with direction
 - Time limit of 15 minutes for discussion per motion for a draft map
 - Chair will ensure each commissioner has at least one opportunity to comment
 - Chair may limit number of comments or amount of time allowed per commissioner
 - Commissioners can request FLO to use DSM to evaluate impact of potential changes
 - Commissioners can ask FLO or other commissioners clarifying questions
 - Vote called after 15 minutes
 - Pass or Fail, the Chair moves on to a motion for another draft map
 - After each draft map has been considered once, a new motion may be made regarding any map with a previously failed motion
 - Motion process repeats until all draft maps have a Passed motion OR three motions fail to provide direction on any map
