The communities of Fallbrook, Rainbow, and Bonsall are all essential parts of North County. We share North County institutions, such as the County offices in Vista, veteran facilities, medical care, shopping, education (Palomar College), and entertainment along the Highway 76 and 78 corridors in Oceanside and Vista. Fallbrook shares transportation issues with neighboring North County communities along the Highway 76 and 78 corridors, relying on the North County Transit District. We share youth sports leagues and churches with neighboring Oceanside and Vista, in addition to other social and cultural opportunities. We share roads, plus postal and fire protection services with our neighboring North County communities of Oceanside and Vista.

We need to be represented by just one County supervisor, who understands the connections between these communities. Please do not create a map that will isolate Fallbrook, Rainbow, and Bonsall from our neighboring North County communities.
