Our community of Fallbrook has been a part of North County for far longer than the 21 years I have lived here. We no longer have a hospital, and thus share vital resources to provide for our communities of Fallbrook, Bonsall, Rainbow, De Luz and including Camp Pendleton. As a Trustee on the Fallbrook Regional Health District Board, I am able to inform you that we share safety and emergency services with our North County Fire Protection District, Cal Fire, our local FQHCs in Fallbrook and Vista, hospital services of Tri City, Palomar Hospital and the 24 hour urgent care service in San Marcos. We have coordinated services during the Pandemic with our partners throughout North County, and ensured through these partnerships the ability to provide our communities with local testing and vaccine services. Our communities utilize the educational services of community colleges located in San Marcos and Oceanside, as well as the Cal State San Marcos University. We share our agricultural roots with the communities of Vista, Oceanside, Escondido and San Marcos. We share similar fire safety concerns with our North County neighbors, as well as water resource needs. And we share resources for our social services through combined Health and Human services offices located in Fallbrook, Escondido, Vista and Oceanside. Our homelessness programming is offered in Escondido, Vista and Oceanside. Our social identity is closely connected to being a part of North County. We have no service or working relationships with East County communities that I am aware of. Most of our communities sit on the West side of the I-15, with major use corridors of the 15, 76 and the 395. As a portion of Carlsbad is included in our D5, I would add that this community shares the least commonalities with our North Inland communities. Our roadways require maintenance and updating for safety, and we have advocated for our desperate need for public transit within our communities. Most of our community members traditionally have commuted for their employment to either San Diego or other North County communities.
