I live in Escondido and I feel that the issues and needs of Escondido are not addressed in several of the draft maps. Often Escondido gets lumped with the East County areas when we have very little in common with the Eastern most areas of San Diego County. Escondido has been changing and becoming less of an agricultural area and more of an urban area. Many agricultural areas have been sold to developers for large housing developments, our business and technology district have been growing. We have a large blue collar work force, many of which have to travel on both State Route 78 and Interstate 5. Our needs in regards to public transportation have increased.
