THANK YOU to the Chair and to the Commission for allowing me to share my thoughts.

My name is Lila MacDonald. I have been a resident and involved member of the community of Fallbrook for over 50 years and I sent comments earlier in the process, representing the community in my role as the CEO of the Fallbrook Chamber of Commerce. Today I address you as native Fallbrook Resident.

Fallbrook is an unincorporated area in San Diego County. We identify as North County and have since long before I was born. We have different needs, issues and concerns that are not shared with the communities of East County, South County or even the City of San Diego.

North County, is a separate "community of interest" and we share many common North County services, such as Sheriff, Fire and CHP, Health care & educational facilities, water, Transit and social & cultural traditions.

We share concerns about agriculture and fire safety.

Separating our unincorporated areas of Fallbrook from North County cities in which we have established relationships for the safety and well-being of all of our communities is detrimental and can tear apart years of hard work, and could give rise to increased crime, health concerns, increased poverty, increased fire safety issues and decreased resources.

In addition to the Inland communities of Fallbrook, Rainbow, DeLuz and Bonsall, please include the Tribal lands in North County. We need one Supervisor to fight and represent us at the County Board, not have our needs pushed to the side, destroying our communities and the relationships that have been built to keep North County residents safe, educated and stable.

I urge you to Respect our community identity and character and keep us a unified North County.
