I want to thank the Commissioners for their hard work, for listening to the community during these past few months. I support draft map 6. That map is leaning toward a direction that will hold up the values for all our communities as a whole in the County of San Diego. I appreciate that plan 6 currently is in the direction of following the Voting Rights Act. Having the South County areas as a Majority-Minority district will keep the traditional Latino Communities in the South Bay like San Ysidro, Chula Vista, and National City with other border communities with a significant Latino population like Jacumba, Campo, and Potrero. The breakdown is as follows: District 3, to create a density for the Black, Muslim, refugees & immigrants communities. As well as keeping the historic LGBTQ community in the district. District 5, to unite Escondido along with the other four cities: Oceanside, Carlsbad, Vista, San Marcos, along freeway 78. This region has grown very quickly and shares a number of healthcare, transportation, business, public safety, and recreation resources. While respecting the strong veterans' presence & the Latino community of interest. District 4, to allow the rural areas to have a better & cohesive representation. And also a significant Native Peoples Community of Interest in tribal lands. District 2, to reflect the coastal community of interest, from Encinitas all the way down to include Coronado & Pt. Loma. As well as maintaining the density of the AAPI community. I encourage the Commission to listen to the community members & move forward with plan 6 tonight.
