My family and I would like to offer our public comment not to separate out our community (San Diego Country Estates), which is in Ramona, from the unincorporated town of Ramona. We share services, school systems, highways, and many amenities, as well as sharing the same equities for more rural sections of East County or cities such as Poway. Lumping us in with coastal cities of Del Mar and Solano Beach does not give us adequate representation because we are just a few tens of thousands of voters, not the hundreds of thousands they are.

Let me provide a specific example: We have grave concerns about expanding highway 67; however, I seriously doubt that the very populated areas of Del Mar or Solano Beach transit that highway, let alone care about making it wider and four lanes wide the entire section. It is a vital highway, which must be widened and during the fires in 2003 and 2007, one of our only ingress/egress routes. Towns or cities such as Ramona, Julian, Lakeside, Poway, and El Cajon share the exact concerns of our little community, the San Diego Country Estates, and when we vote for our Supervisor, Diane Jacobs or now Joel Anderson, we know that they are representing East County interests and equities.
