I'm writing to show my support including the cities and local communities of Santee, Lakeside, Blossom Valley, Alpine, Pine Valley, Julian, Potrero, Campo, Jacumba, San Diego County Estates, Ramona, Santa Ysabel, Poway, Lake Henshaw, Borrego Springs, Descanso, Lake Jennings, Crest, Jamul, El Cajon, and other east communities.

Other areas of interest such as the Kumeyaay and Pala territory tribes including Viejas, Barona, Jamul, Campo, Santa Ysabel, Pala, Sycuan, and Pechanga Band and others should be in this map as areas of interest. The East County communities have common interest, I include Santee as part of this interest. These communities follow highway 15. Most of all are east of the 15 freeway, north of highway 8 and or the 94 to the East San Diego County borders.

Grossmont Cuyamaca College District covers 1,138-square-mile district includes two colleges, Grossmont and Cuyamaca. serves students in the Lakeside, El Cajon, La Mesa, Spring Valley, and Santee; Grossmont Union School District Serving Lakeside, El Cajon, La Mesa, Spring Valley, and Santee; Grossmont Healthcare district and Grossmont Hospital serve over 500,000 people from Spring Valley to Campo, this also shows an interest in these communities. Padre Dam Water District stretches from Santee to Alpine. The Helix Water District stretches from parts Casa De Oro into El Cajon. As you can see these communities all have similar weather, similar values, some farming, shopping centers, etc.. To divide these communities would be harmful to East County.

The Santee City Council has recently passed a resolution that requests the County Independent Redistricting Commission work to retain and maintain East County San Diego communities of interest. The resolution was adopted by the City Council of the City of Santee, California, at a Regular meeting held the 10th day of November 2021.
