Dear Commissioners,

As an Alpine resident I have concerns with the redistricting changes that I believe will be adverse to the well being of our community. Our ranch was severely impacted from the the Alpine West Fire of 2018 and I have great concerns about decisions that might put our community at further risk of fire. Separating us from others in our fire district would likely undermine & weaken our fire protection.

Overall, I fear these district changes will create a lack of cohesivness & efficiency by combining districts with discordant needs and goals. All communities have unavoidable challenges. We are in hopes that those with decision making influence will effect changes allowing for coordinated & symbiotic efforts within their districts, thus avoiding the creation of new, avoidable challenges.

As a rural community we have little in common with Riverside or Imperial. Communities with such divergent needs would likely face considerable disadvantage from this redistricting.

As we recover from a pandemic, fires and other challenges, we hope those influencing our destiny will have our best interests in mind and hear the voices of the Alpine community.
