Unincorporated East County shares a Highway 67 corridor connecting Ramona, Poway, and Lakeside with everyday activities such as youth sports and hiking; along with shopping, social clubs and workplace destinations. We are not tied to the communities of Chula Vista nor Solana Beach in this same manner.

The total unincorporated population, at 500,000 residents, creates the second largest community in the County of San Diego - the City of San Diego is the largest community.

This second largest community in the County of San Diego is currently represented by two County Supervisors: District 2, Joel Anderson and DIstrict 5, Jim Desmond.

This second largest community in the County of San Diego is in danger of losing one of its two County representatives due to County redistricting activity.

Loss of County representation would, in effect, dilute the vote of the unincorporated population - this action will disenfranchise the rural, unincorporated voter.
