I'm writing to show my support of District Map 4 on the website sdcountyredistrictingmap.org/supervisors, this includes the cities and local communities of Santee, Lakeside, Blossom Valley, Alpine, Pine Valley, Julian, Potrero, Campo, Jacumba, Ramona, Poway, Descanso, Crest, Jamul, El Cajon and other east communities.
