To the Commission:

I write to express my support for Draft Map 13a V.1 -6 because it provides the most representative district for North County.

As the Mayor of San Marcos, I know well the interconnections between the urban and rural areas of North County and the incorporated cities, Unincorporated communities and the Tribal Reservations of our region. I am writing as an individual, however, my 16 years of service on our city council have given me a strong understanding of the manner in which public services in North County often cross city and special district lines. For example, the San Marcos Fire Department, a city agency, also provides fire protection service to portions of the unincorporated North County. Similarly, the Vallecitos Water District, a Special District, provides water to most of the city of San Marcos along with a number of Unincorporated communities. In North County, there are dozens of examples of these cross-jurisdiction services. They are decades old and reflect the organic way that North County developed over the last one hundred years.

Map 13a V.1-6 is the best representation of the North County Community of Interest by drawing a Supervisorial district that addresses the varied needs of this region.

I also want to thank you for your fine service to San Diego County residents. Your attention to preparing a fair and representative set of Supervisor districts is laudable and will ensure that all voices are heard over the next decade.

In closing, I ask you to support Map 13a V.1-6 when you next meet on December 2.
