First, I would like to thank IRC for working diligently to ensure fair redistricting for San Diego County. That said, I want to express my support for Map 14. While neither Map 13 nor Map 14 is perfect, Map 14 has several key attributes to address the concerns of several communities of interest, including AAPI, LGBT, Black, and Muslim. Map 14 keeps the urban areas along route 78 together since they share similar concerns at the County level. On the other hand, variations to Map 13 will divide the AAPI community, and BIPOC will not have a fair representation. For the last ten years, there has been a significant change in demography; the redistricting should reflect the change instead of maintaining the status quo.
