Harmony Grove and map 13A

This is to express a strong preference to see the Harmony Grove area remain in the same supervisorial district as the City of Escondido. As the commission may know, the boundary area between incorporated cities and unincorporated communities give rise to several issues such as transportation infrastructure, fire protection and resource preservation in which coordination, communication and cooperation are key. By having one rather than 2 supervisors involved it will be far easier to facilitate such actions. This is particularly true in the Harmony Grove area - where there are issues pertaining to the MSCP and to transportation infrastructure such as the completion of Citracado Parkway. The current version of Map 13A will help facilitate dialogue around these complicated issues. Moving Harmony Grove to the "Coastal" district would, I fear, likely result in more difficult coordination and less progress in solving difficulty policy issues.
