The indivisible community is served by a single elected planning advisory group, a single school board, and a single water district. I serve as a director of the water district that provides fire and emergency services, parks and recreation, sewer, and water services to the indivisible community. Road ingress and egress from the indivisible community is very limited, and converge in central Ramona to provide the primary access corridor to the remainder of the mountain "backcountry." Central Ramona is the closest location where Estates residents may obtain food, fuel, hardware, and other commercial services.
