I have lived in the Fallbrook/Bonsall/Vista area since 1992. I appreciate the commission's hard work, but of the maps presented only two accurately depict a geographic area for the 5th district that makes any sense, maps 13 and 13B. The current district boundaries keep communities together that share services and share a common identity in their economic focus on agriculture. Fallbrook, Bonsall, Oceanside, Valley Center, Pauma Valley, Vista, parts of San Marcos and Escondido all share a common agricultural economy. Our concerns are over available water, defensible fire zones, economic vitality to the agricultural communities within our towns. We also have cross over in water districts, fire districts and school districts. The North County Fire District covers all these communities. Our health care and hospitals cross over these community boundaries. Our children attend schools outside of the community in which they live. Our agriculture is supported by residents who live within these specific communities. We inhabit a large geographical area, with a large BIPOC population, but would be losing our voice if any of those communities were excluded from the district or if large portions of the far eastern part of the county were added to it. We have nothing in common with East County, if you just take a drive into our towns, you would see a distinct difference. We need a voice who will represent us and our unique concerns. We want to thrive and responsibly grow our communities in a manner that befits our history and culture. Please keep the N County communities together.
