- Maintaining the proposed PANA district which keeps the core of the Black/Muslim community of interest together & keeps the LGBTQ communities together while creating a majority minority district which reflects the demography and cultural diversity of San Diego's central region
- Ensuring a majority Latino district in South County as required by the Voting Rights Act.
- Keeping the Historic Barrio District together in South County
- Removing Coronado and Pt. Loma to prevent dilution of Latino voting power in District 1, and
- Creating an East County district that unites as many rural communities of interest as possible.
