Maps 13a, 13b, and 14 push the rural areas of San Diego into competition with more suburban areas by merging their districts further west. 13b has Campo and Clairemont in the same district which would mean there would be communities that need help with things like well water, electricity, and internet access also looking for support alongside communities who have completely different needs and complicating factors. 13a has Campo, Tierrasanta, and Miramar all as one district- which leads to an insanely huge range of needs that the district would be in charge of handling and would likely lead to some areas being prioritized over others and leaving many without the necessary support. 14 has the same issues and also includes issues with clumping rural areas more north- you have areas of mainly desert now grouped with mountains and forests- Valley Center is going to have wildly different needs compared to Descanso, Julian, or Borrego Springs.
