Dear Commissioners,

I am Rudolf Streif a member of the Chaldean community in East County and live in Rancho San Diego. I would like to thank you for your hard work of finding a good solution for the redistricting.

I would like to address the fact that while your current draft maps keep many East County communities together such as Lakeside, Alpine, Jamul, Santee, Ramona and Poway. I am surprised that in some of your draft maps El Cajon, Rancho San Diego, and Spring Valley are not and have not been included in East County. Areas such as Lakeside, Ramona, Alpine and Santee have shared economic, social, and cultural interests with El Cajon, Rancho San Diego and Spring Valley and we need to be kept together. We own our businesses in El Cajon, our children go to school in El Cajon, our churches are in El Cajon and we have more in common with East County San Diego than the City of San Diego.

Some of the proposals would also split the area that is served by Cajon Valley Union School district between two county supervisor districts. I don't think that is a good solution for the school district either.

My proposal for Supervisor District 4 is to include all of the rural interfacing communities in East County in one: Ramona, San Diego Estates, Santee, Lakeside, Winter Gardens, Bostonia, Granite Hills, El Cajon, Rancho San Diego, Casa de Oro, Crest, Harbison Canyon, Jamul, Alpine, Descanso, Pine Valley, Potrero, Campo, Jacumba, Boulevard, Spring Valley, and La Mesa.

These are the communities we live in, we do business with, whose restaurants we patronize frequently, and more.
