Dear Redistricting Committee,

I would like to voice my concern regarding the proposed redistricting map, specifically, the intent to remove Torrey Hills from the rest of Carmel Valley (District 1).

Geographically, there's the Los Penasquitos Canyon that separates Torrey Hills from the rest of district 6, thus make little sense to isolate Torrey Hills from its current surrounding neighborhood (district 1).

Financially, it is not fair for Torrey Hills residents to be excluded from the neighborhood infrastructure that they help financed for the past many years via property taxes. The majority of Torrey Hills property taxes has gone toward maintaining Del Mar School Districts and building up of various infrastructures in Carmel Valley such as the Carmel Valley Recreation Center and the Ocean Air Recreation Center.

Communally, any polling should reveal that the majority of Torrey Hills residents feel a greater much more sense of belonging to the greater Carmel Valley area; moreover, most Torrey Hills resident consumes goods and services within District 1, primarily due to the physical divide from the Los Penasquitos Canyon.

Thank you and hope you reconsider the current redistricting map to include Torrey Hills into the rest of Carmel Valley (District 1).
