I have been serving the Chaldean Community, our church, our youth programs; and community members actively for over 15 years and I care deeply about my community. There are approximately 70,000 Chaldeans that live in east county in the cities of El Cajon, La Mesa, Spring Valley, Rancho San Diego, Lakeside, Santee, Alpine, and Poway across all of east county. I encourage the commission to please keep the Chaldean Community together in East County. I oppose the current maps that show part of our cities that are combined with North Park, Hillcrest, and the rest of San Diego. This proposal does not work for our community because we do not share any community interests with them. Their communities are not only far away from us but they also outnumber our community members by far. By separating our communities apart you are taking away our voice and our representation. We have much more in common with our neighboring cities which we share our school district, our highways, and our churches. Please commissioners, do not allow this to happen. Please keep the Chaldean Community together in east county. Please don't let the other uncommon, unrelated communities dictate our voices and our culture.
