Thank you for the opportunity to provide citizen comment on the County Redistricting Commission's efforts developing new district maps. One thing COVID and climate change has taught us is that any inequity found in our community becomes reinforced and multiplied when stressors are applied. Communities that previously had no voice continue to get short-changed unless conscious structures are developed to make sure their voices are heard. This applies to voting and community representation in running for office and serving on volunteer boards and commissions. You have an important mandate to make sure these communities of color are not marginalized or disempowered by the boundaries you draw. For that reason I strongly encourage you to continue to work on refining IRC Draft Map 14. I specifically call attention to the Voting Rights Act that there must exist a majority Latino district in South County, the ability to maximize AAPI concerns in the coastal district, and a possible Black/Muslim majority minority district in the central region of San Diego. Thank you for your consideration of these important issues.
