I am very concerned about the representation of both North County communities and marginalized groups on these redistricting maps.

I want to thank the Commissioners for their hard work & for listening to the communities during these past few months. I am a part of the Communities Together Coalition supporting draft map 14, as it keeps communities together & will make San Diego County stronger.

Keeping the urban areas along the 78 together since they have similar issues and concerns at the County level It respects the Tri-City hospital region and keeps it together.

It recognizes different needs of incorporated cities and unincorporated communities.

It recognizes the strong veterans presence along the tri-cities corridor.

And other versions of North County just don't work. They cause chaos in other parts of the County tearing apart communities of interest and warping the coastal district.

None of the Map 13 options work for us. Map 13a divides the voices of coastal north county communities.

Draft map 14 has the support of representatives from diverse communities who have come together to try to find agreement. This map will serve all of our community of interests, including:

AAPI in the coastal district

the BIPOC & LGBTQ communities in the central district

uniting the cities along the 78 freeway

rural communities of interest in East county

respects the Voting Rights Act for the South County's Latino community.

Draft map 14 is a map that we can accept together because it will keep all of our communities together

Again I urge you to please do what is best for the residents of North County, keep our communities together and strengthen our county by adopting draft map 14. Thank you for your consideration.
