I support the 13A map variations because they protect the North County BIPOC/Latinx community of interest by keeping Fallbrook, Oceanside, San Marcos, Vista, and Escondido together. North County has many cooperative agreements that are crucial to our functioning including overlapping services such as law enforcement, fire protection, and health districts.

I oppose Map 14 and its variations because it violates Fallbrook's 48% Latinx protected class population by diluting its voice and separating it from the rest of its BIPOC community of interest that includes Oceanside, San Marcos, Vista, and Escondido. Further, Map 14 would lump Fallbrook, Rainbow, Bonsall, and Valley Center in with a GIANT nearly 3,200 square mile East County-centered district that consists of 85% of all of the county's unincorporated areas. This map does not ensure equitable representation for our unincorporated communities.

I ask the Commission to move a 13A map forward as a final option.
